

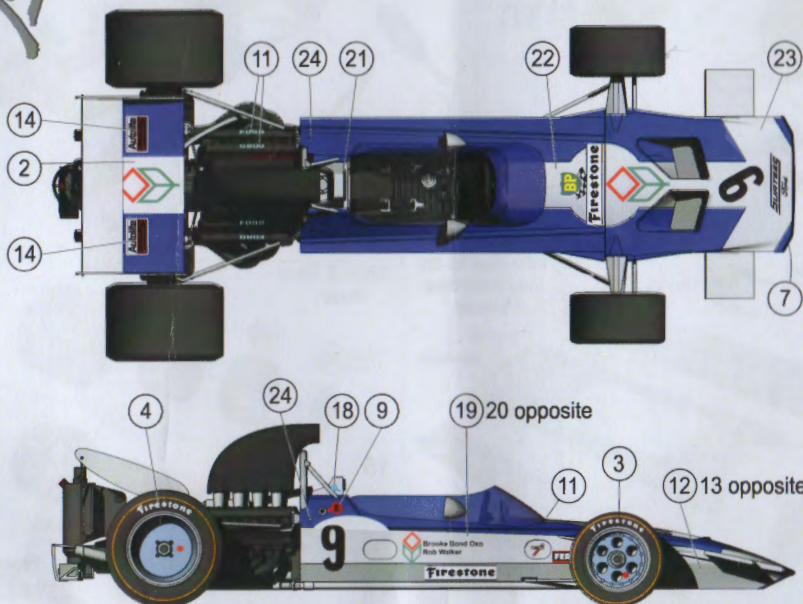

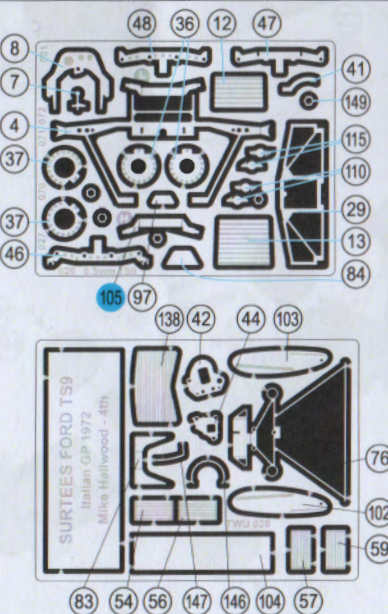

Mike Hailwood returned to GP racing at the 42nd Italian GP at Monza, his first GP since Monaco 1965. In his Surtees TS9/004 he qualified in 17th position. He managed to get himself up to the lead group early in the race and by lap 25 took the lead for the first time, a great moment for Team Surtees. For the last 5 laps the battle was on between Hailwood, Peterson in the March 711, Cevert in the Tyrrell 002, Gethin in the BRM P160 and Ganley in his BRM still in touch, none of them having won a Grand Prix before. First across the finish line was Gethin followed by Peterson, Cevert and Hailwood with only 0.18 of a second covering them all. A new record average speed was set at 242.615 km/h.
