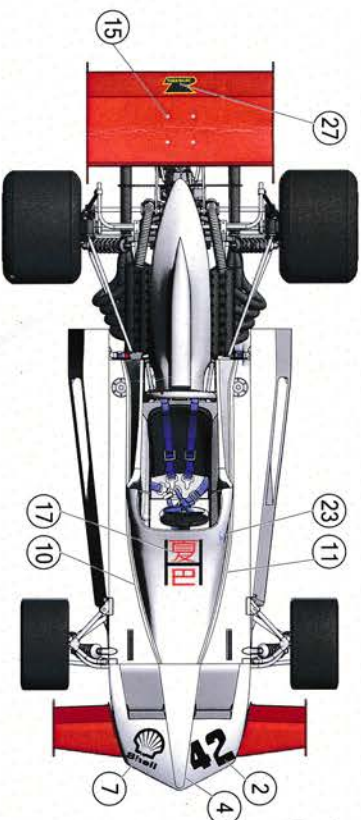
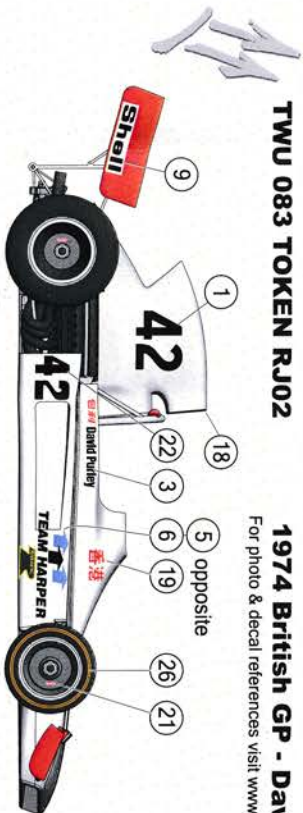

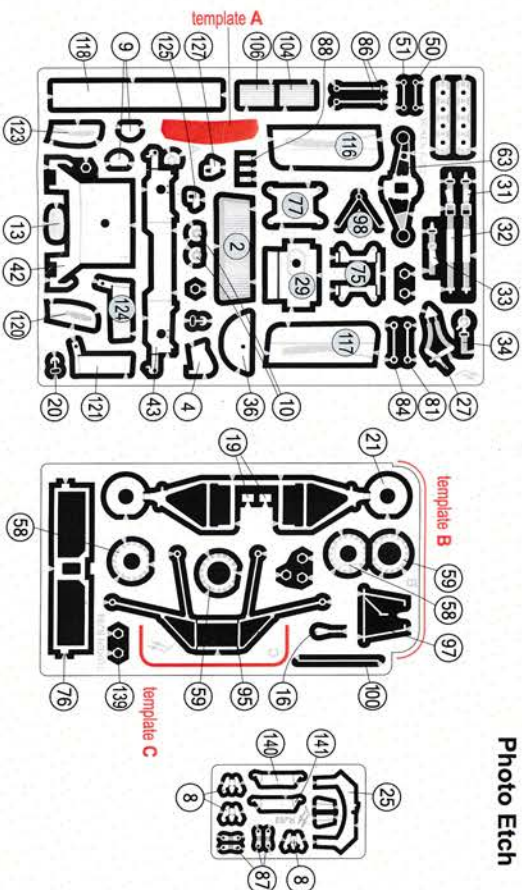

Team Token was denied entry for the Monaco GP based on the supposed inexperience of their driver, Tom Pryce. This prompted Pryce's move to Shadow for the rest of the 1974 season. At the time David Purley competed in F2 for Hong Kong based millionaire Bob Harper driving March and Chevron cars. Team Harper then entered the Token for Purley for the 1974 British Grand Prix. Unfortunately he failed to qualify for the race. The car was now painted white and red instead of the original green and yellow and a new, taller airbox was also used.
