



PREPARATION Remove feeds and mould lines from casting, filling if necessary. Drill out holes for petrol cap etc. Rub body down with fine grade wet and dry paper to give a good finish. Ensure all parts fit prior to painting adjusting if required. Add nose section to body. Paint all parts prior to assembly, we recommend using aerosols of car touch up paint, undercoating first then top coating as shown below.

ASSEMBLY A two part epoxy resin is recommended for gluing the model together. Add track rod assembly to front axle assembly and glue to chassis adding rear axle assembly and rear suspension dampers at the same time. Glue seat in place followed by side frame members, front bulkhead and dashboard. Add petrol cap to body. Add steering column to steering wheel and add to dashboard when set. Add tyres to wheels, gluing wheels onto axle stubs. When set add body to chassis. Fit radiator grille in place, followed by exhaust, bonnet clips and finally bonnet strap. Trim vac-form to shape and add to cockpit. Finally add transfers to body as shown. PAINTING Body should be finished in Ecurie Ecosse Blue, wheels black, seat, radiator grille matt black, steering wheel rim gloss black. Chassis and dashboard silver, bonnet strap leather, exhaust aluminium.
